

# CCCMB Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

## Tuesday, November 18, 2025 - 5:30 – 7:00pm

1. Agenda requests & introductions as needed - Wolfgang has made extensive improvements and updates to the website such as a new Events Archive. James presented an idea for a Google Project Tracker spreadsheet for current project updates, especially long term projects. Paul - Outreach to the community and getting more volunteers.  
Jim - Find ways to engage current members for more active involvement with CCCMB.  
Nia - Stickers with a QR code to get the word out. Get top five priorities to roll on first.
2. Approval of minutes (5m) John made a motion to approve the October 2025 meeting minutes and Morris seconded. All in favor.
3. Admin/Social Media Coordinator (30m) - Nia Brunskill is newly hired by the Board for this new paid position by Board email vote. Kathy made a motion and Gregg seconded. All in favor. She will work as a sole proprietor and CCCMB as client. She has checked into a professional insurance policy for herself. 4. Agency / Land Manager updates & discussion as needed (20m)

**SLO County** - Frans is going to the planning meetings for promotion of the El Chorro bike park. Kathy reported that SLOPOST is willing to donate up to \$50K for the Sapwi extension project along with funds from Atascadero Horsemen. Tom Becker still has to get a permit and insurance. Volunteers can only be present on the days that he is working. Craig Campbell will be managing Tom on the layout and eventual construction and he has asked for volunteer help. [Kathy will email Tom Becker's proposal to the Board for review before making a motion for new funding for trail completion.](#)

**Los Padres Forest & Cal Poly/West Cuesta** - We have permission to install a bell box at the top of Shooters. [Morris will check with Niels to get a gate key for TV Tower Rd.](#) Craig Campbell reported by email that the Red Dog Trail improvement is again in the works.

**City of SLO** - Righetti Hill Bunny Hops beginner trail is finished now, although it is closed until it dries from the rain. The Wednesday city crew is working on the Backburn hiking trail and Niels is doing maintenance on the Filliponi Connector. Eneko says we need to resume inspections of the Eucs. Forest Service is working on the road to the Eucs. Shooters got brushed by a non-CCCMB trail steward. Maybe FS?

**State Parks** - Ongoing Friday trail maintenance on Oats Peak and Barranca at Montana de Oro. Paul made a motion by email to the Board to fund \$250 for a volunteer lunch for the Friday crew which Morris seconded. All in favor.

**Land Conservancy** - At Pismo Preserve, Panhandle berms work is scheduled for next Monday. Bob is in discussion with Scott Couture and supervisor John about a new trail. Scott now has a mini excavator.

**Morro Bay Bike Park** - No report.

**Financial** (Gregg) - Gregg reported by email that we have \$71,563 currently. CaMTB annual dues have been paid. New Venmo QR code has been created, CCCMB Donate. 1Password subscription paid. The Board approved transferring \$50K of these funds to a new interest bearing account with Wealthfront. Land owner Dave Shanks donated \$1000 for trail maintenance on his private CCCMB created trail and \$250 was collected in donations at the Bovine Classic event. New contract with Nia for 1099 position. Establishing a new CCCMB physical mailbox tabled until December meeting.

**Sponsorship & Bells** (Morris) - \$250 in cash donations from the Bovine Classic event. Great exposure for CCCMB from a lot of visitors to the Central Coast.

**Membership** (Bob) - Bob reported that we have 254 members currently: 226 IMBA and 26 supporting. Wolfgang has made numerous updates to the website
