

CCCMB Monthly Board Meeting Minutes

1. Agenda requests & introductions as needed - A friend of Brian Bennett donated an assortment of used tools to CCCMB. A few leaf blowers, a chainsaw, hedger, string trimmer and an assortment of tools were included. Paul is checking them over and adding them into our inventory.
2. Approval of minutes (5m) Eneko made a motion to approve the November 2025 meeting minutes and John seconded. All in favor.
3. Agency / Land Manager updates & discussion as needed (15m)

SLO County - Craig reported the Sapwi extension construction is now in progress. Volunteers are greatly needed. Monday, Wednesday and Friday workdays are currently available. Weather dependent. Kenny reported that so far about 2/10 of a mile have been completed. January 17, 2026 will be the first weekend trail work date, 8AM - 3PM. [Eneko will look into promotion of the workday using the Front Page or EventBrite apps.](#) [Kenny will work with Nia on a Sapwi announcement with the next newsletter and on Facebook and for flyers to be distributed at Super Bowl Sunday for Frank's crew to hand out. New bell box installed at the Blinn Ranch trailhead by Morris and John.

Los Padres Forest & Cal Poly/West Cuesta - Cal Poly wants to complete a master plan for approving new trails. In regard to Red Dog, Bob Hill is handling most of the communications with Cal Poly, as it is expected to be a city trail. Eneko reported that he, Wolfgang and Joel Craighead worked with Niels on drains/reversals on Shooters.

City of SLO - The workday that was scheduled for January 25th is cancelled. Niels wants to hold off on digging.

State Parks - Cerro Cabrillo has been the focus for work lately.

Land Conservancy - Bob reported that Scott has an outline for two new trails at Pismo Preserve for approval. No funds available at this time, so the Board suggested that CCCMB would be open to funding new projects when a budget is available. Eneko suggested a fundraising campaign. Christie O'Hara sent us a check for \$1,058 from former Bovine Classic proceeds.
