Guest Discussion: Jeff Ebner, State Parks (45 minutes) - Jeff Ebner, Environmental Scientist for California State Parks gave a presentation on his many roles working for State Parks. He identifies plant and animal species with the park Alan. He is one of only three in the Coast District approved to operate a drone and has been using it for geological surveys. He is actively involved in the mapping and designation of trails. For trails management, he has developed a field data collection workflow for reporting projects using the phone app Quick Capture by esri.
