State Parks - Jim reported by email to the Board that ongoing brushing work is happening on Fridays in Cerro Cabrillo and Montana de Oro. SP hosted a trails committee meeting on October 15. A new app ArcGIS QuickConnect with the SLO coast district is now available for reporting trail maintenance needs. The next SP Trails committee meeting will be January 21, 2026.
